



terms & conditions

If you require any clarification, please ask a committee member. This is just a shorthand guide.

a) do not:

- incite, encourage, or present for its own sake **violence** or brutality
- **mislead** or alarm listeners by simulating news or events
- present as desirable the use of **illegal drugs**, the misuse of **tobacco** or **alcohol** as well as other harmful substances
- Glamorise, sensationalise or present **suicide** as a solution to life problems. In particular, broadcast material should not provide explicit details about the method and/or location of a suicide attempt or death.

b) no discrimination:

We will not broadcast material that is likely to stereotype, incite, vilify, or perpetuate hatred against, or attempt to demean any person or group, on the basis of **ethnicity, nationality, race, language, gender, sexuality, religion, age, physical or mental ability, occupation, cultural belief or political affiliation**. The requirement is not intended to prevent the broadcast of material which is factual, or the expression of genuinely held opinion in a news or current affairs programme or in the legitimate context of a humorous, satirical or dramatic work.

c) coarse language:

Do not say n**r or c*****

- The one exception is in music, which will require a language warning, and must not be considered discriminatory
- A language warning must have been issued at the start of a conversation where you plan to swear or you play a song which is explicit
- Never use language in a way that could be considered discriminatory

d) discuss in good faith:

- If you are having a debate, don't try to be "edgy" and unnecessarily controversial. We all love a 'shock jock', but there's only one Chris Moyles.
- Have an open mind and prepare to have your mind changed!
- **If a discussion you hear on KCL Radio makes you feel uncomfortable, please contact a committee member**
- **Most importantly - HAVE FUN!!**

agreement:

I agree to all of the terms and conditions listed above, and I understand that breaking any of these rules will result in the instant cancellation of my programme and non-refundable withdrawal of my membership.
